As a member of our National Volunteer Corps, you'll work closely with our scholars. You'll support their academic success. You'll help them navigate the challenges of adolescence. Your example will encourage them to become men and women for others—young people who will return to their communities empowered to help others and inspired to do so.

Members receive ongoing training and support of their service and personal and professional growth, health coverage, travel expenses, a bi-weekly stipend, and a Commitment to Service Award in the amount of \$5,000 at the end of a successful year of full-time service. Members who live in the BHGH home as part of their role will also receive room and board.

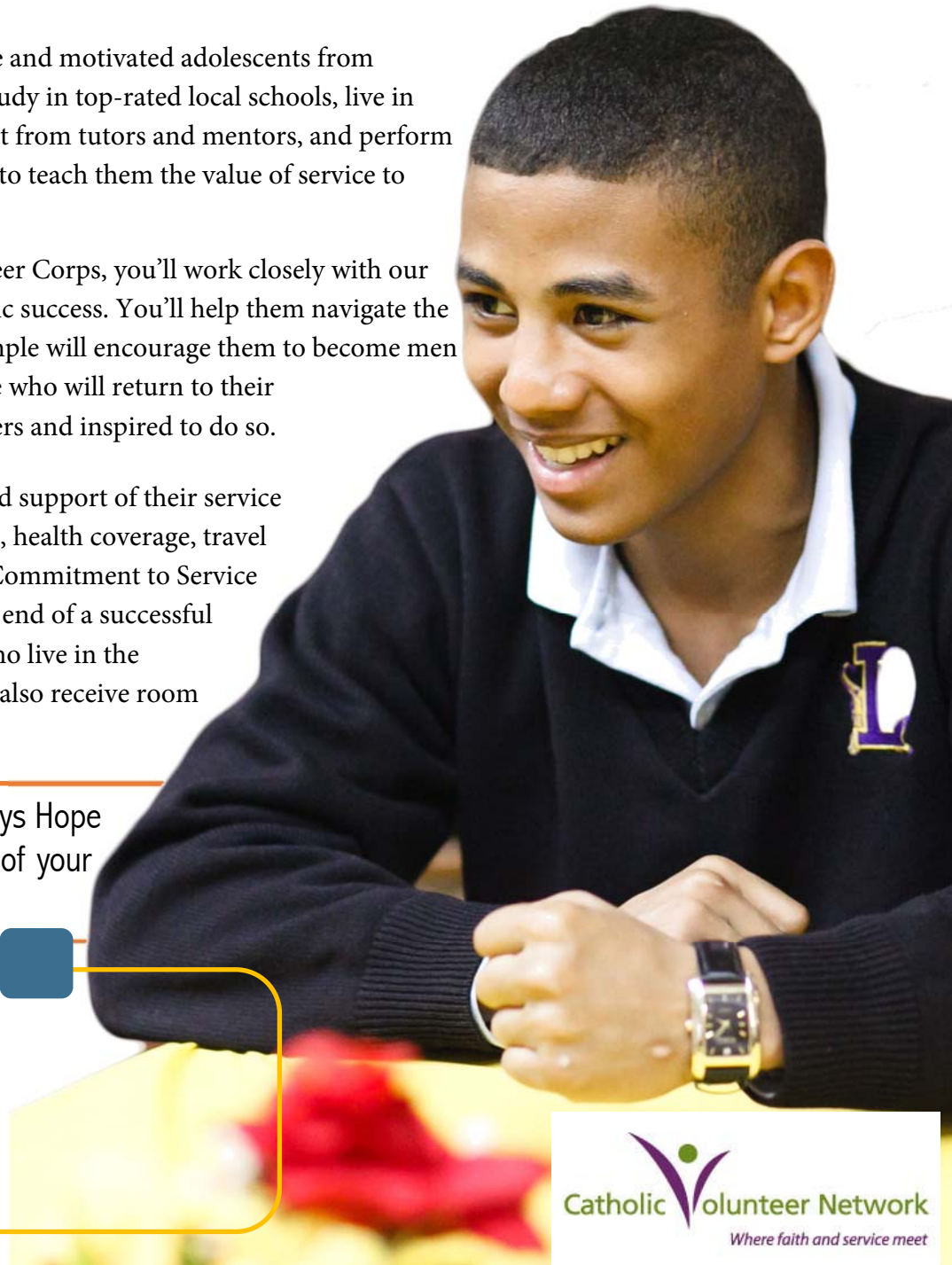
